Originally thought a dark form of *Prays fraxinella* (Ash Bud Moth). But DNA barcoding indicates that *P. ruficeps* is a species distinct from *P. fraxinella* (Ash Bud Moth). The latter does have a dark form but in it the faint *fraxinella* markings can still be distinguished.

*P. ruficeps* has an unremittingly black forewing without any underlying sign of 'fraxinella-ish' markings, and a 'rufi' 'ceps', (Red/Brown Head), though this can vary somewhat in the 'rufiness' of the 'ceps'. [John Langmaid, Aug 2013]

It was accepted as a valid species in the new British list 2013, though this is not yet reflected in Sterling, Parson & Lewington or on UKMoths.

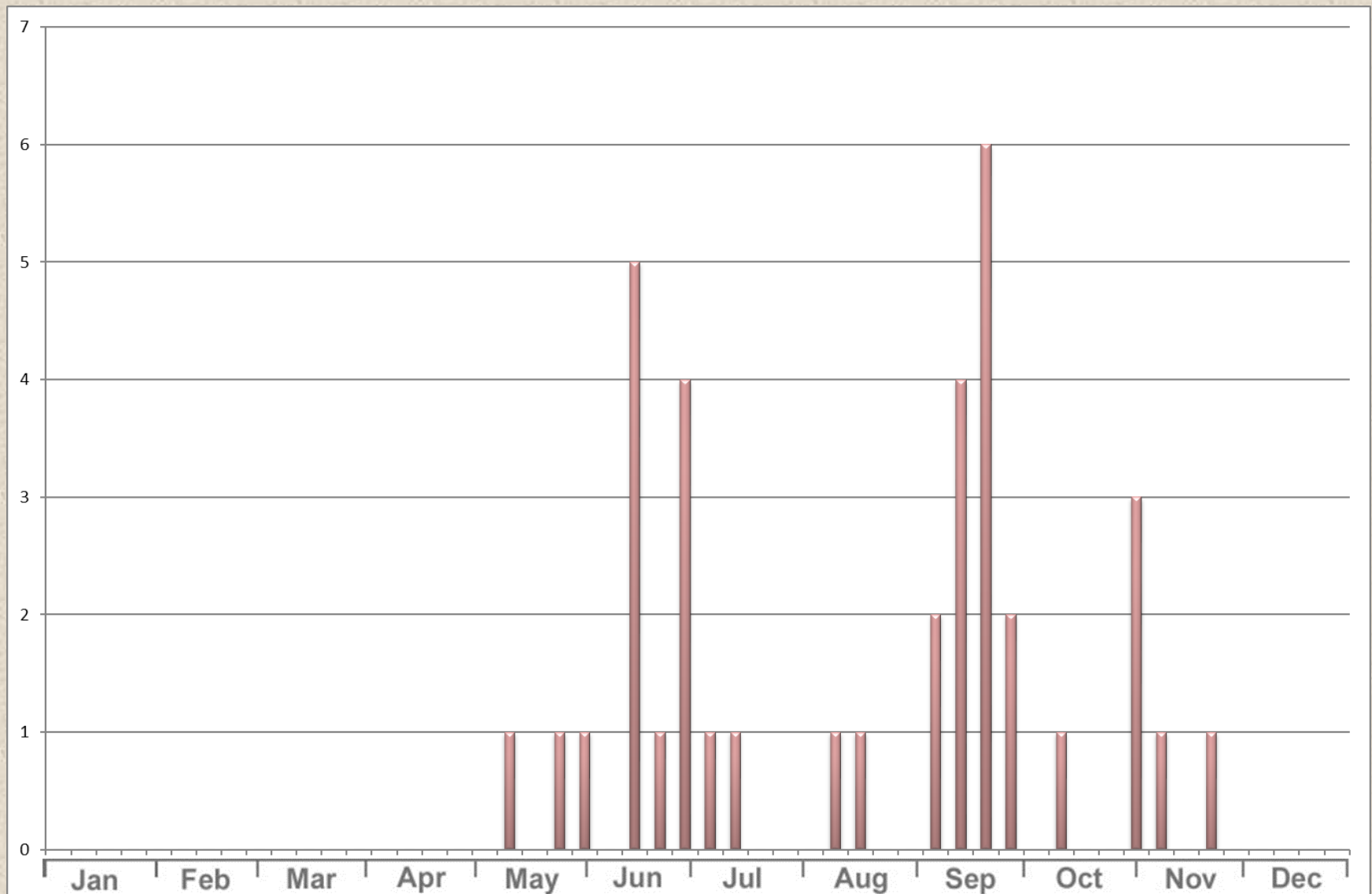

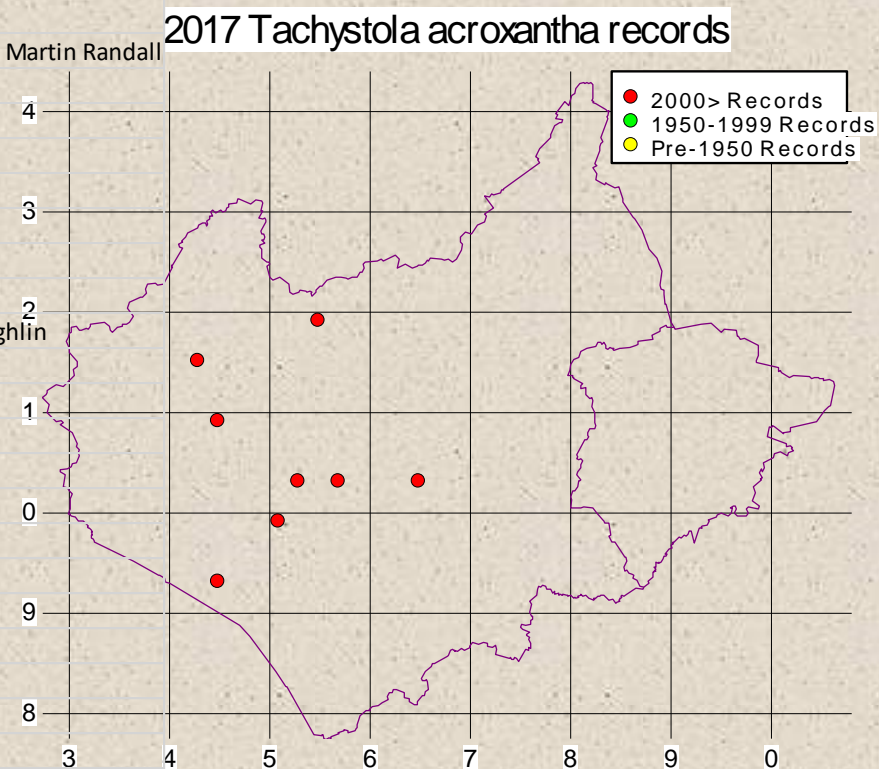

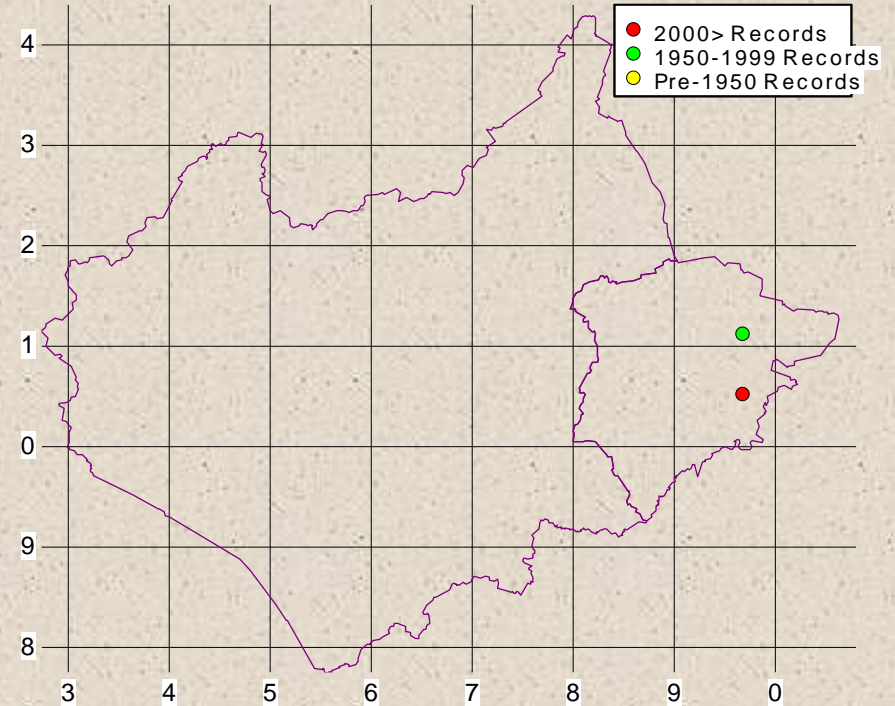

## 2017 Annual Moth Recorders Meeting

There was also another record of a possible *trauniana*, photographed a few days earlier by Mike Higgott (below left).

Whilst the costal strigulae in Mike's photo seemed to match *trauniana*, the costal blotch looked more like *regiana*. Therefore, without a specimen, that record has been classed as "unconfirmed" (for the time being at least).

All recorders are asked to keep a look out for *trauniana* in 2017, particularly on or near Field Maple

**MBGI:**

*Pammene trauniana* is generally smaller with the outer edge of the pale yellow medial blotch on the dorsum nearly straight and closer to the tornus; the yellow costal strigulae are more pronounced.

**Bradley, Tremewan & Smith:**

*Pammene trauniana* differ from *P. regiana* in having the medio-dorsal blotch of the forewing pale yellow and subquadrate, its outer edge nearly straight to dorsum near tornus, and costal strigulae interspersed with thick wedges of pale yellow ground colour.

Larval foodplant of *regiana* is given as Sycamore or Norway Maple & probably Field Maple and *trauniana* is given as Field Maple. Both moths below & right were photographed on Field Maple

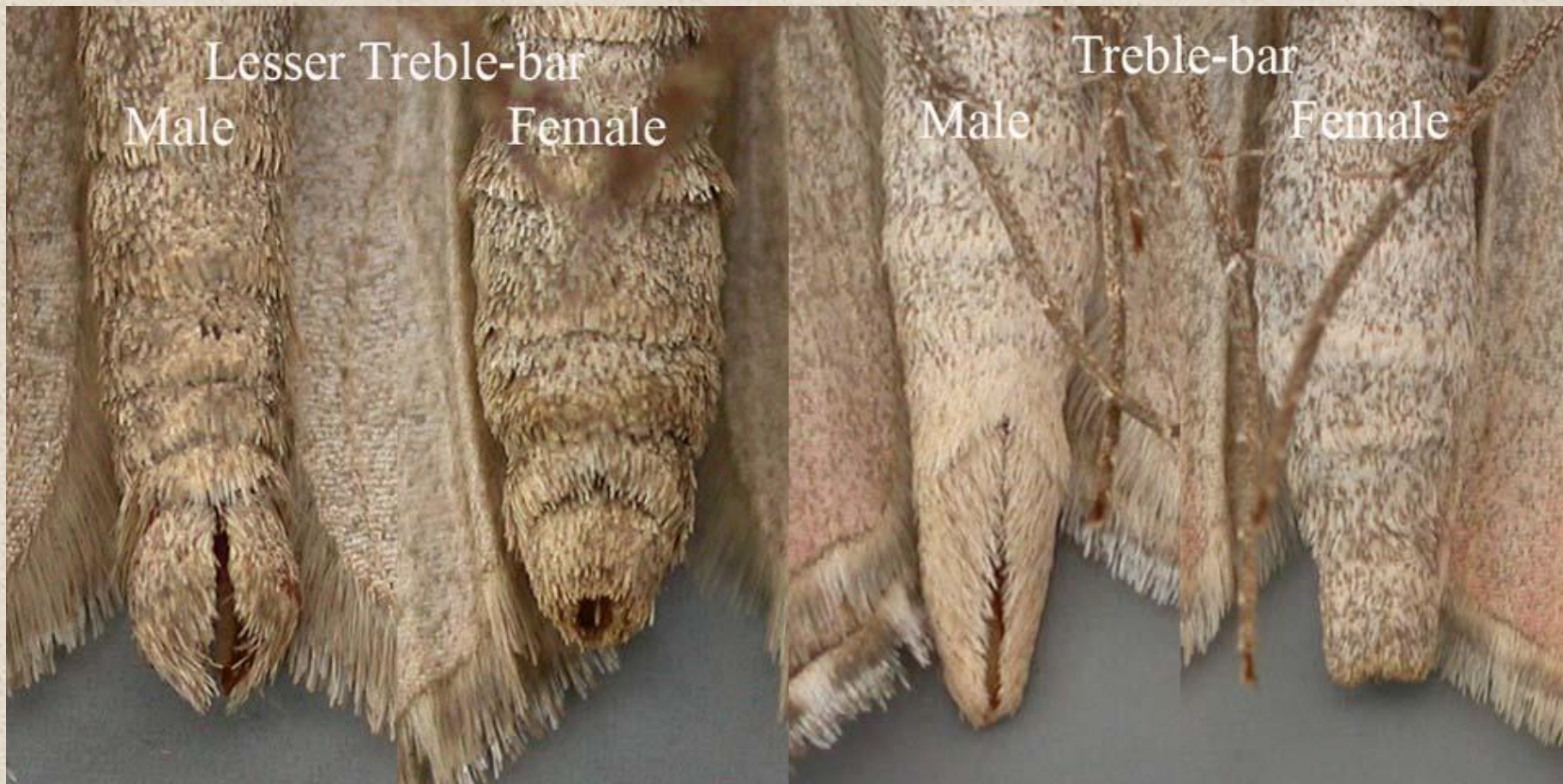

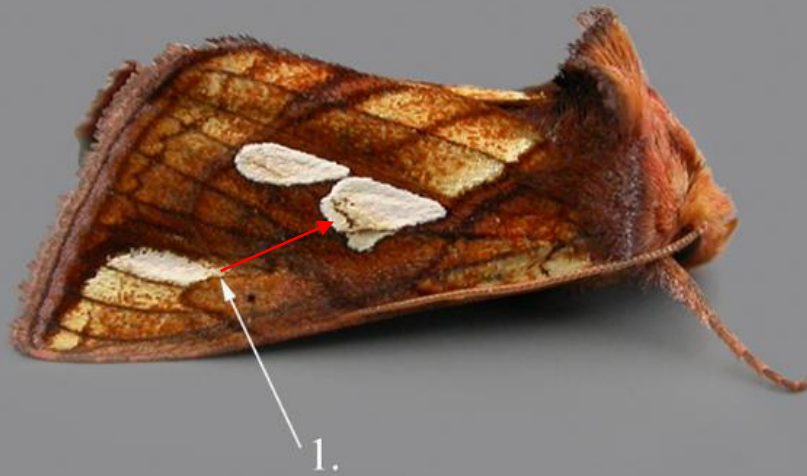

### Biblical two-mile wide clouds of pesticide-resistant insects set to descend on UK

Huge swarm of super moths have invaded Britain from Europe and could devastate farmers crops

Remember the big moth story of 2016?!

**A BIBLICAL swarm of pesticide-resistant super moths has invaded Britain – and is set to annihilate our cabbages.**

Tens of millions of the diamondback moths have flooded in from Europe in just weeks – with reports of TWO MILE wide clouds of the moths.



This is a diamondback moth, swarms of which have invaded the UK from Europe and could destroy crops of cabbages and cauliflowers

The critters feast on cauliflower and cabbages and could devastate farmers crops across South East countryside unless scientists find their "Achille's heel".

The invaders are said to be resistant to current chemicals and scientists are frantically searching for a way to stop the dusty-coloured bugs.

Following reports of a two-mile wide cloud of the pests near Leominster, Herefordshire on @migrantmothUK one follower described the scene as like "driving through rain".

Steve Nash, from who runs the Twitter account, warned: "Once the progeny of this influx arrives in mid-July, numbers could be biblical."

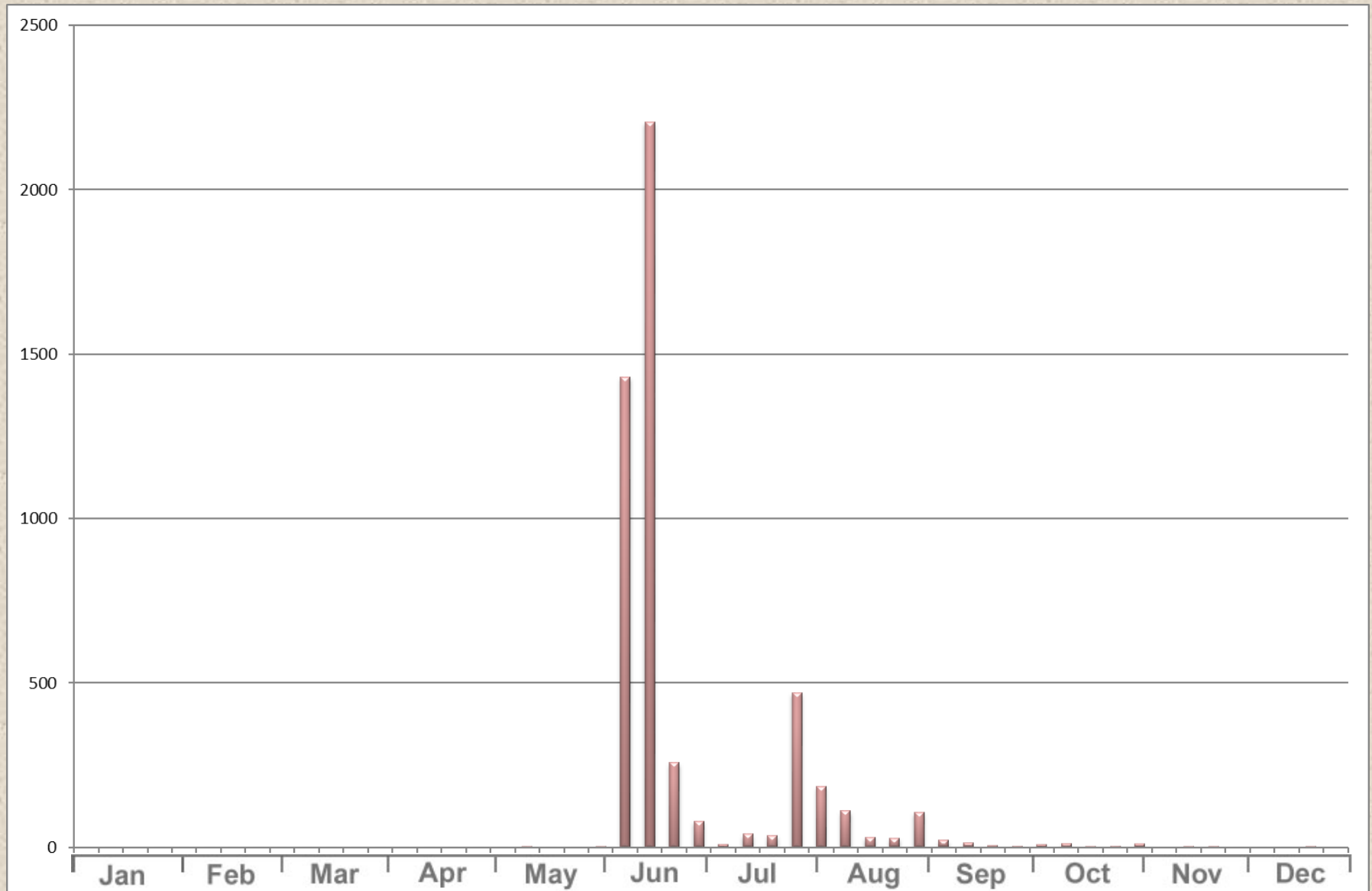
